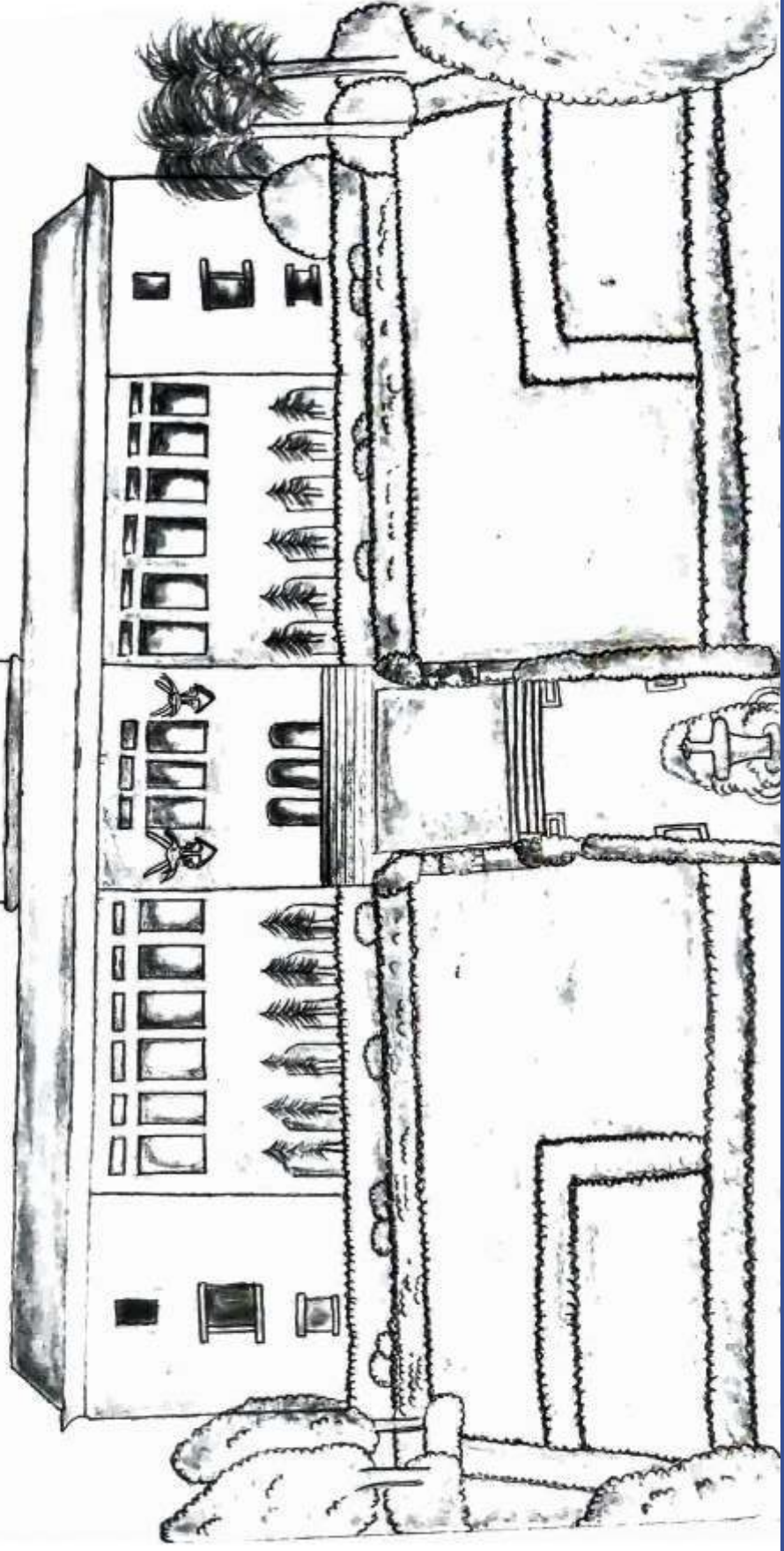
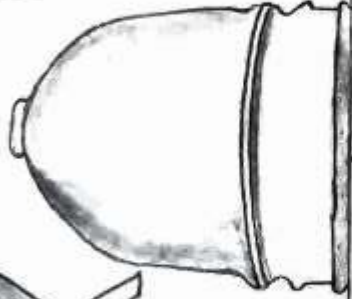

Chemistry

They elaborated on how the moldable plastic material is composed of chemical compounds of cornstarch, glycerine, and food coloring agents. The spectators lauded their efforts to showcase the preparation of bioplastic and the uses of bioplastic, which were biodegradable and environmentally friendly. The configuration and composition of different molecules forming different shapes and different geometrical structures in different compounds was a fantabulous display of their genius.

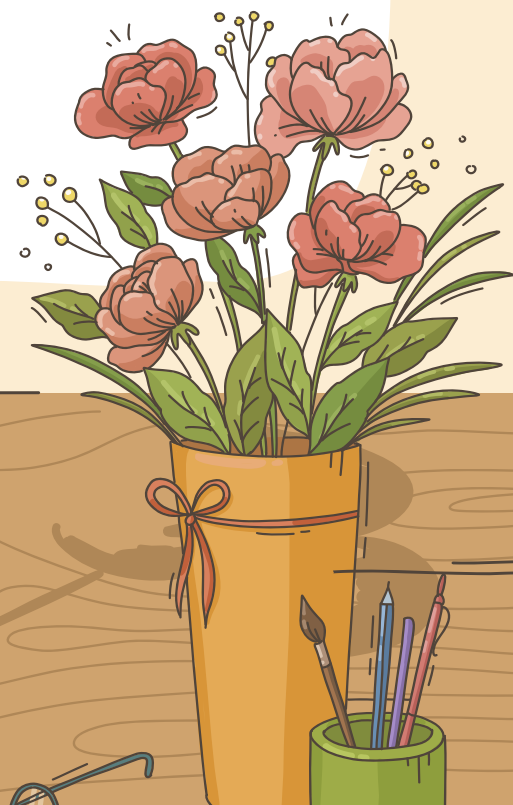
TEACHERS DAY *Celebration*

He stressed on the fact that it is more glorious to serve the societal needs with integrity rather than becoming an authoritative IAS officer. He

added and asserted that one can become a politician as well as an IAS officer but a politician cannot choose to become an IAS officer.





Chandrayan - 3 Program

The launch of the third lunar exploration mission of the Indian Space Research Organisation (Chandrayan-3) was witnessed through the direct telecast of the programme by the cadets of the Pratham Pag, supervised by Pratham Pag Director, Mr. Sandeep Gupta and the cadets of the Foundation wing were enthused and enthralled to see the launch. The entire Pratham Pag and DDA fraternity swelled with pride at the successful mission to the moon. They expressed their elation by repeatedly enunciating “Bharat Mata Ki Jai” and the DDA campus reverberated with the slogan.

It was Pratham Pag staff and faculty members, Director Mr Sandeep Gupta and DDA team that made elaborate arrangements to allow the direct telecast of the launch of the Chandrayan-3 mission targeted to conduct research on the moon. The Pratham Pag Director cherished the accomplishment of this great mission by India and congratulating the countrymen, including students, and also paying a patriotic salute to the scientists along with expressing gratitude to them. He added that after the success of Chandrayan-3, India will become one of the most powerful nations in the world.

Chandrayan-3 was launched through the LVM3-M4 rocket on Friday at 2.35 p.m. to reach the natural satellite of Earth, the Moon. ISRO asserted and instructed that the Chandrayan-3 mission has its propulsion module behaving like a communication relay satellite. It made a spot landing on the moon, and after a brief scrutiny and observation on the surface of the moon, this space agency researched new terrain in remote areas that was yet to be explored on the moon. There was again a possibility of the spot landing on July 23 and 24, 2023. The weight of the rocket was 642 tonnes, and the height was 43.5 ters. It was India's first mission to land on the southern pole of the moon. Before Chandrayan-3, Russia, America, and China made their spot landing on this southern terrain of the moon.

The Scientists of Indian Space Research Organization team have accomplished the mission of landing on the surface of the moon and by making such an achievement, ISRO has fulfilled the lifelong aspiration of fluttering the Indian National Flag ‘TIRANGA’ on the surface moon which indeed makes every Indian swell with pride. Such programs inspire the students to have the patriotic spirit in them so that they see themselves as the custodians of ethical and moral values of India and are filled with the enthusiasm to do something exceptionally great for their country.



VISIT TO IMA FOR POP

As part of an educational tour organized by Sandeep Sir's Doon Defence Academy, Pratham Pag prodigies and DDA diamonds had the privilege of witnessing the passing-out parade. The event, scheduled for June 10th at the Indian Military Academy (IMA), showcased 374 gentlemen cadets, including 42 foreign cadets.

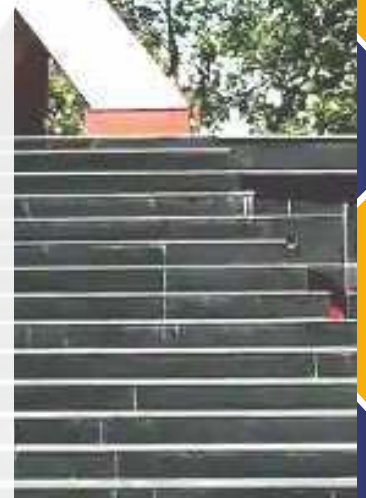

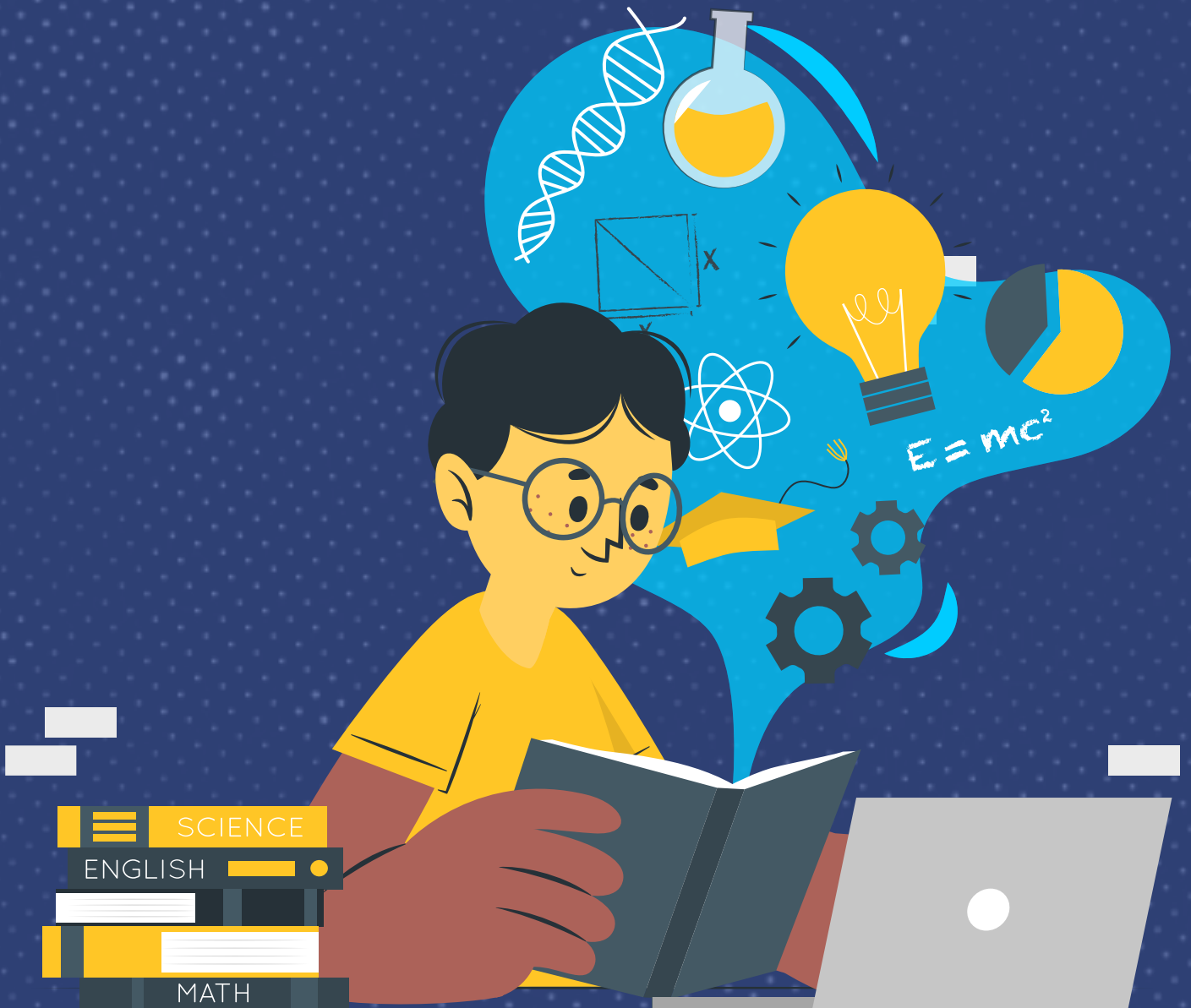

THE PERSONALITY WHO INFLUENCED ME THE MOST

- DAVID GOGGINS

Strength does not come from physical capacity. It comes from indomitable will.



We are all influenced by some reason or another. Sometimes, this influence is everlasting, and sometimes it is only for a little while. But through these influences, we get to learn some great lessons, and this is what shapes our personalities and, subsequently, our lives. I was greatly influenced by David Goggins, who has a multifaceted personality, and due to his robust mental and physical attributes, he has achieved the most improbable.

What I mean to ask the readers is, do they find the above contention true? I wish to give the example of David Goggins, who is a Navy seal, an ultramarathon runner, an ultra-distance cyclist, a triathlete, a public speaker, and the author of two memoirs. He became popular due to his exceptional accomplishments in sports at the International Hall of Fame. Born on February 17, 1975, he was honoured with the VFM Americanism Award in 2018 for his service in the United States Armed Forces. He also published a New York Best Seller titled 'Can't hurt me', Master Your Mind, and 'Defy the Odds'. Apart from these attributes, the magnificent personality has a record-breaking count of 4030 push-ups in 17 hours. As per his biopic, he did not have a normal childhood. It was full of adversity. As his abusive father beat up his mom, the mother, along with young David, went to stay with David Goggin's grandparents. He had a historic 36th African-American Navy Seal in the United States Navy's ancient records. This sports icon is regarded as the toughest man ever known. He ran with a broken shin. Despite all these adversities, he was consistent. What we know about him is just the tip of the iceberg. ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES ARE WE TAKING OUR ENVIRONMENT SERIOUSLY GREEN HYDROGEN AS A FUEL - CAN THIS POSSIBILITY EXIST ?

The greatest threat to our environment is the effect of Global warming and green house gases. It is important to know various important factors to save our environment from degrading any further. Natural calamities like floods, droughts, avalanches, snow blizzards and feminine have invaded human for times immemorial but the harms caused by a human like environmental pollution, ewastage and many such hazardous impacts are making our beautiful planet nothing less than a hell. So let me share with you a few facts that can throw light on some productive steps we can take after knowing some scientific facts.

Hydrogen exists only in combination with other elements and has to be extracted from naturally occurring compounds such as water. But then, you must be thinking how it is a green fuel? It is during the splitting of water during the process of electrolysis using a device called electrolyser that is powered entirely by renewable energy ie wind energy, hydroenergy etc, and then it is called green hydrogen.

While the potential of the hydrogen as a clean fuel source has a history of nearly 150 years. It was only after the oil price shocks of the 1970's that the possibility of Hydrogen replacing fossil fuels came to be considered seriously.. Three car makers - Japanese Honda, Toyota and South Korea's Hyundai have since moved decisively to commercialize the technology albeit on a limited scale.

POTENTIAL IMPACT OF GREEN HOUSE GASES

Green Hydrogen has specific advantages. The first advantage is the clean burning molecule that can decarbonize a range of sectors including iron and steel, chemicals and transportation. Two renewable energy that cannot be stored or used by the grid can be channeled to produce Hydrogen.

AUTO SECTOR FUEL CELLS

Hydrogen is an energy carrier, not a source of energy. Hydrogen fuel must be transformed into electricity by a fuel cell stack before it. It can be used to power a car or truck. A fuel cell converts chemical energy into electrical energy using oxidized agents through an oxidation reduction reaction. Fuel cells convert Chemical energy into electrical energy using oxidising agents through oxidation-reduction reaction. Fuel cells based vehicles most commonly combine Hydrogen and oxygen to power the electric motor on board. Since fuel cell vehicles use electricity to run, they are considered as electric vehicles. (evs) Hydrogen fuel cell cars have a near zero carbon footprint. Hydrogen is about 2-3 times as efficient as burning petrol because an electric chemical reaction is much more efficient than combustion. For example Toyota Mirai and Honda Clarity. Such environmental initiatives need to be taken by the government and the people to reduce environmental problems.

Actually, a drone is a flying robot that can be controlled through a remote and can fly autonomously with software-controlled flight plans installed in its system that work jointly with sensors and a global positioning system. In the armed forces, three Medium-Altitude Long-Endurance Uncrewed Air Vehicles (UAV) developed by DRDO. Rustom has three variants: Rustom-I, Rustom-H, and Rustom-II. With a payload capacity of 95 kg and a length of around 5.12 m, Rustom-II can attain a maximum speed of up to 150 km/h and operate along the LOS.

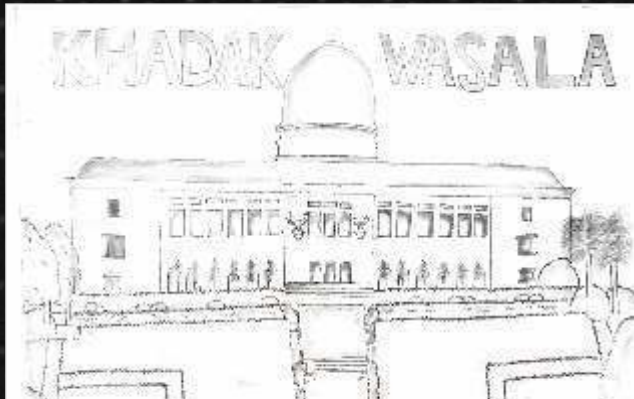
